A word from Evangelist Dave Kistler

On the top of the 555' Washington Monument are inscribed two words in Latin. They are the words, "Laus Deo" which simply mean, "Praise Be To God!" Those words appropriately describe what our Lord did this past Thursday and Friday in Washington, DC, during our "Patriot Project" Bible distribution.

For months now, we have been asking for your prayers for this outreach. The Lord responded above and beyond what we could ask or think. One of my main concerns (at this time of year) was the weather conditions for this type of outreach. Washington has been inundated with extremely severe weather for weeks. However, we could not have asked for better weather for our two days (65 degrees on Thursday and almost 80 on Friday with beautiful sunshine)! Charlie Rangel (NY), even getting to briefly present the gospel to him--an encounter that the Lord set up, as Cong. Rangel's office had not agreed to grant Dan a meeting to present the Bible.

However, in the near future I may be able to do so. As many of you know, she is a rising star on the political landscape and may make a run for the presidency in 2012. I have seen her many times on T.V. and have been quite impressed. Let me assure you that she is, in person, all that she appears to be in publickind, gracious, intelligent and engaging!
